Pre season work

Before the start of the grass cutting season, usually April, we will undertake the following work. Staff will normally make 3 to 4 visits per month, plus time for salting.

January/February
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Salting and snow clearing, including topping up salt bins, dependent on road conditions from York.• Pruning/reducing certain shrubs, to keep pathways clear and maintain visibility in car parks.• Remove dead leaves and debris from shrubs, rose beds, drying areas, car parks and grassed areas. Lightly fork over shrub beds where possible.• Check condition of trees, replace stakes and ties as required. Carry out any tree pruning as agreed.
February/March
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Replanting of shrubs. Division of herbaceous plants if required.• Pruning of roses including shrub roses.• Application of a pre emergent herbicide on shrub beds, rose beds and drying areas.• Reforming grass edges to footpaths and shrub beds.
March
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• One application of a general fertiliser to shrub beds and a rose fertiliser.

Grass cutting season

The grass will be cut once in late March and once in April, depending on weather conditions. It will then be cut fortnightly until the end of September, with a final cut in October. Staff will also undertake the following work.

At every visit
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Keep rose, shrub beds, drying areas, wall bases and footpaths weed free by hoeing or spraying.• Check grass edges to shrub and rose beds and trim the edges as required.• Cut, spray or trim off grassed areas missed by machinery (eg around signs or lampposts).• Check roses and deadhead as required.• Clear litter.
May/June and Aug/Sept periods
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Apply two applications of herbicide to grassed areas.
May and July/Aug
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spray roses on two occasions to help prevent/control pest and disease problems.
June
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Remove dead/dying bulb foliage from shrub beds.
Once per month
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sweep or blow car parks clean.
May, June and July
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Apply 3 applications of rose fertiliser when weather conditions are suitable.

July onwards
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pruning of early flowering shrubs to keep shrubs off pathways.
July/Aug
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Boundary hedge cut to the existing height and width.

End of season work

This work will be carried out from October onwards. All areas will be sprayed with weed killer when weather permits.

Oct/Nov
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Replanting of shrubs as agreed with residents.• Pruning/reducing shrubs.
Nov
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Old foliage of perennial plants removed
Nov or Dec
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Site will be visited once to remove leaves from grassed areas, car parks and drying areas.
Nov/Dec as required
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Filling salt bins.
