#### Welcome home

From general care to more complex needs, the aim is to ensure that residents and their families feel welcomed, happy and 'at home' from the moment they arrive. In short, residents are encouraged to lead as fulfilling and independent a life as possible and to be fully supported by the dedicated care team.

#### Safe and supportive

The recently built care home of New Lodge offers 45 individual care suites, each with en-suite facilities, lift access and fitted with an Emergency Call System, providing residents with immediate access to the care team. Situated within secure and private gardens, residents can spend time relaxing outdoors.

New Lodge is currently following strict Government guidance on the control of COVID-19 and all care staff have access to full PPE. All care staff and residents (new and existing) are regularly tested for the virus and 2-metre social distancing is currently being adhered to.

To control the virus, New Lodge is currently closed to visits from family members, friends and volunteers, but this will be regularly reviewed in line with expert guidance. home is in close contact with families and friends to ensure that communication between residents and their families are maintained throughout the pandemic, with initiatives such as 'Connection Cafes', which allow residents to see their loved ones at social distance and by setting up regular video calls and encouraging families to send 'care packages'.

An experienced and empathetic team of registered care practitioners and support staff are all equipped to provide 24-hour high-quality residential care.



#### The Home and Facilities

The residential care home is located within Rowntree Lodge, which is located within the wider development of New Lodge. The care suites are located in a two-storey building with views over the landscaped gardens.

Beautifully designed and decorated throughout, it is a Stirling Standards dementia-friendly building. The communal areas have been individually designed making it feel homely and welcoming. Residents have access to all communal areas which includes the garden room, choice of dining rooms and lounges, social seating areas as well as the private and landscaped gardens.

Baz Larner, activities coordinator says of his role:


